### OUTREACH NOTES

Lest anyone think we've been hibernating in anticipation of cold weather, let me assure you that FCC continues to reach out to our neighbors. In Galatians 6:2, we read, "Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ." We are trying to ease the burdens of those around us in a number of ways.

**Blessing Boxes:** Since summer, we've been counting our blessings by contributing to our Blessing Boxes. Our blessings and our thankfulness to God for those blessings will enable us to share God's love by purchasing Christmas gifts for children through the Salvation Army's Angel Tree. Peggy Daniels has worked tirelessly on this effort, and on Oct. 30 and Nov. 6, the Youth will help collect our Blessing Boxes. Please remember to count your blessings and to give generously to this special effort.

**Backpack Buddies:** With the start of the school year, we joined Vineyard Family Services' efforts to supply food to the neediest children in area schools. We are working with Vincent Elementary School and supplying food bags for 22 children who would otherwise have little to no food over the weekend. Vincent Elementary has a large number of students who are in great need; approximately 72% of their students are on free or reduced price lunches. Sandi Hamilton is heading up our participation in this effort.

**Book Drive:** Our newest effort is to collect 1200 books for local elementary schools (Inverness, Oak Mountain, and Vincent). It's difficult for me to imagine a home without books. Just as children need food and clothes, they also need books—books of their very own. Books provide entertainment, hopes, and essential literacy skills for young children. We're looking for gently used and/or new books suitable for kindergarten through third grade. Do you have some good children's books around your home that you could donate? Bring them to the Outreach table in the Nathex or contact Charlotte Brammer if you have questions.

**Sunday School Benevolence:** The adult Sunday school classes continue to reach out to the Owens House as well as local elementary schools. Gary Howard has recruited Gloria McWilliams and Regena Varvoutis to help in our efforts to serve Inverness Elementary and Oak Mountain Elementary. The backpacks we collected and stuffed in July really were a blessing to the children in these schools. Currently, we're anticipating cold weather and are collecting coats and hooded sweat shirts for children at these schools as well as at Vincent Elementary. Do you have **Koatz4Kids**? **Food Panty:** We will be opening a food pantry at FCC soon. As many of you know, the Sunday school classes have been preparing dry food boxes to assist families in immediate need, and then we have supplemented with Angel Food boxes as needed. In September, Angel Food Ministries closed, and we do not currently have access to a similar food source.

We are working to fill this gap for local people who need food. Stay tuned for more information on this important mission.

**Odds and Ends:** You may have noticed that we opened up as a Mission Station for one week in September for a group from Ohio. Our sister churches in Tuscaloosa and Cottondale are now open as Mission Stations for ongoing Tornado Relief. We continue, however, to partner with Central Church of Christ in Tuscaloosa. We purchased socks and underwear for approximately 40 children from Alberta City whose school and neighborhood were destroyed on April 27<sup>th</sup>. Jerry and Rita Wallace as well as Bob Smith have been instrumental in our efforts in Tuscaloosa.

These generous outreach efforts are only possible because of your generous support. Thank you for all that you do to help our neighbors.
